Whether you still live in New York or have moved...

Many of us recently received this email from New York State Governor Kathy Hochul: We're working hard to deliver for New Yorkers across the state — and we want to keep you up to date on the issues you care about. That's why I'm hoping you'll take a moment to let me know what's on your mind and what issues matter most to you.

We've also learned: NYS Bills A-10425 and S-09347 would have guaranteed educators the health insurance benefits with which they retired. Back in June 2022, Acting Governor Hochul stated she would approve this bill. The Legislature approved the bills December 2, 2022 and sent them to the Governor to sign into law. However, Governor Hochul vetoed that legislation on December 12.
